

BEAR CREEK LAKE FISHING RULES

1. All Pennsylvania State Fishing Regulations (including seasons) apply to Bear Creek Lake. Anyone fishing must possess and display a current Pennsylvania fishing license as well as a current BCLCA Member badge.
2. Fishing is not permitted from the dam, the breast of the dam, or at beach areas.
3. BCLCA currently limits the number of fish kept by each person to four (4) within a 24 hour period. Any small fish caught to be used as bait count toward the daily limit.
4. The only live bait permitted in Bear Creek Lake are worms, nymphs, larvae and pupae of any insect spending any part of their life cycle in Bear Creek Lake waters.
5. Our BCL lake management consultant provides us with harvest recommendations based on their latest population survey.

The recommendations for years 2017 -2019:

1. No Bass under 20 inches can be taken.
2. No Sunfish under 7 inches can be taken.

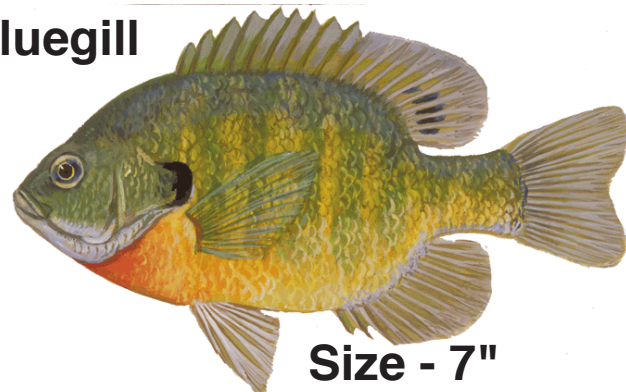

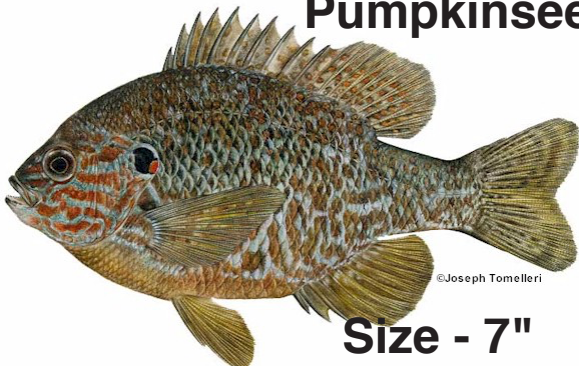

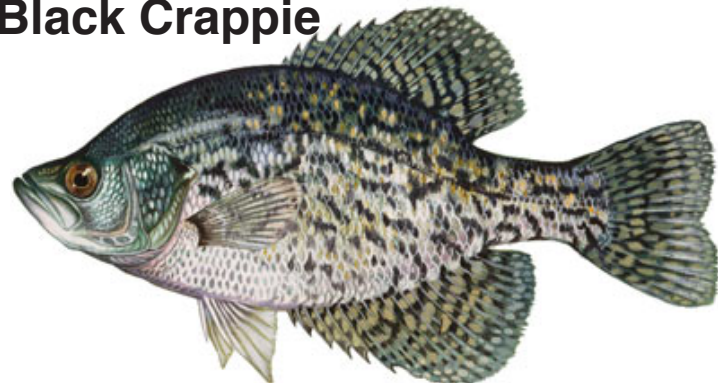
